## Ask CRRC | Population Sizes and Sample Sizes

**Q:** The 2010 Caucasus Barometer includes about 2,000 completed interviews in each country: Armenia, Azerbaijan, and Georgia. However, the three countries vary in size. How can the same of a similar sample size be appropriate for each country?

**A:** Great question! Contrary to popular belief, the total population size has little effect on the necessary sample size. Necessary sample size is more dependent on the amount of variability between members of a population. [Read more...](#)

As of June 1, CRRC has started work on a collaborative project on youth engagement, called MYPLACE.
