You have the right to refuse the interview, however, I ask you to help me do my work to help us understand what is going on in the country.

This interview will take 40 to 50 minutes, depending on the size of your household. I will need your help to identify the adult household member I will be interviewing. It's very important that we follow certain steps while identifying this member of the household.

Let's talk about your household¹. By "household" we mean people presently living with you most of the time, regardless of their legal place of residence, and who share income and expenses. I would like to ask you to tell me <u>only</u> about the members who currently live with you.
